Reading- 15 minutes/day

Earth Day was in April. However, EVERYDAY is Earth Day! So...please continue to take care of our earth and complete the following activities! :)

Continue to enjoy a book everyday! Pick a book to be read to you and enjoy some cuddle time and discuss the story!

Monday - All About Earth Day (mini book)
"Butter Up" all popcorn words (sight words)
Practice reading the book.

Make a list of goals for the summer
Decorate and assemble your bucket.

Math- 10 minutes/day

3D Shapes! Cubes, Cones, Spheres, Pyramids, Cylinders, Rectangular Prisms
Recommendation: Search “3D Shape songs for kids” on YouTube. Listen to a song everyday before completing the math activity.

Monday - Rectangular Prism Page

Tuesday- Sorting Shapes 2D and 3D

Wednesday- Shape Up Page

Thursday- Spin and Graph Shapes

(Use a paperclip and a pencil to make a spinner or have your child close his/her eyes and point to a shape)

Ask your child to name the shape before coloring.

Friday- 3-Dimensional Shapes In My Neighborhood Scavenger Hunt

Monday (18th) - Summer math worksheet with icecream cones.

Tuesday (19th) - Color by Number summer addition page

(Use fingers, pennies, or other manipulatives, if needed)

Writing-10 minutes/day

Please work with your child to write three good sentences each day.

If needed, use the “I Can Write Page” to give your child some ideas.

Remember...Start with a capital letter

Leave spaces between words.

Spell popcorn words (sight words) correctly.

End with a period

Use a notebook you have at home, or the provided journal pages.

Your child may continue to write about what they have done today **or...**

Select a topic from the idea page in the journal.
